Minutes of the Meeting with officials of Wushu Association of India (WAI)

A meeting was held on 10.12.2024 under the chairpersonship of Ms. Sujata Chaturvedi, Secretary(Sports)/ DG SAI with senior officials of WAI at SAI HQs, New Delhi. The list of participants is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

A brief of the discussion and instructions issued during the meeting is as under:

1. Budget allocation and utilization

- The total allocated budget for FY 2024-25 is Rs. 5.0 crore, out of which, Rs. 1.84 crore has been utilized so far. Further, there is one upcoming foreign exposure proposal as per the approved ACTC and the remaining allocated budget for the current FY is expected to be utilized accordingly.
- WAI requested for providing National Coaching Camp and Foreign training, for which proposal will be submitted within a week's time.

2. Long Term Development Plan

- WAI presented a roadmap for Asian Games 2026 and year-wise milestones upto 2032.

- WAI also confirmed that it will update its Annual Calendar for the year 2025-26 within 15 days.
- It was informed that WAI is conducting a talent hunt programme for the upcoming Youth Olympic Games & Asian Games 2026; and the information about the same will be updated by 15th January, 2025.

3. **Coaches Development Programme**

- WAI informed that the Federation is in discussion with the Asian Wushu Federation and Iran Wushu Federation regarding a coaches' training program. The foreign coaches from both Federations will visit India to train our Wushu Coaches.

4. **MYAS Compliance related to website**

- It was communicated that WAI must address the gaps in their website to ensure compliance with MYAS guidelines. WAI submitted that the same will be addressed within 15 days.
- The issue of two active domains was also brought up, and WAI ensured to resolve the same within 15 days.
- WAI had already completed the training for ACTC portal in the morning and it was communicated that future proposals must come through the ACTC portal only.

5. Medals and Performance

- WAI informed that they are aiming for atleast 04 medals in Asian Games 2026, with at least 02 gold medals.

6. Wushu STC Centers and NCOEs

- WAI requested for opening at least one Wushu center in South India, and re-starting the Delhi center for Wushu discipline.
- WAI also requested for increasing the number of seats in the 03 SAI Wushu NCOEs.

7. Equipment Procurement

- WAI also requested for the procurement of equipment as per available budget. The proposal for the same will be submitted shortly.

8. Issues

- WAI was informed that there are several complaints regarding the selection policies, and lack of fairness in the selection trials, which are required to be checked and maintained strictly.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
